

SEPTIC TANKS

It is a known fact that tree roots can be very damaging for septic tanks in the field.

The only guaranteed solution to prevent the intrusion of tree roots in a septic tank field is BIOBARRIER.

Dig a trench all along the perimeter of the septic field to a depth of 39" minimum (1M.) which could extend to 58" (1.48M.) depending on the types of trees that are growing near the field.



With each roll of BIOBARRIER, plastic pegs are provided that are used to secure the BIOBARRIER near the surface of the soil.

Biobarrier's performance is guaranteed for 15 years, but you can expect it to last for 25 and even 30 years!
